Report

That in their opinion the Loganian Library can and ought
to be allowed to use the book cases and shelves in the Rush
Library Building paying an annual rent thereof to the
Ridgway Branch, ~~to be determined~~
and that in their judgment the sum of six hundred dollars
would be a reasonable compensation for the use of the book cases
shelves in the Rush Library Building.

The committee under the direction to report whether in the
arrangement of books in the Rush Library Building there is
the best economy of space, having regard to the actual resources
of the trust estate under O'Rush's will

Report

That in their opinion the books do not occupy more
space than is necessary.

They further report

That they authorize the employment of Parit as night watchman at
\$1²⁵ per night and authorize McElbert to purchase one of Buerk's Waleham
Time Detector for \$75. and belt for \$2⁵⁰ additional, also to purchase two
five Extending Champions No 1.

They consider it inexpedient at present to employ an extra day
hand in addition to the family Mc Grath.
