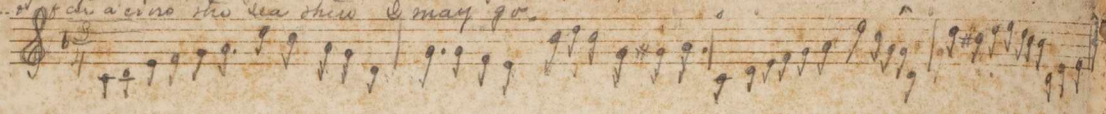
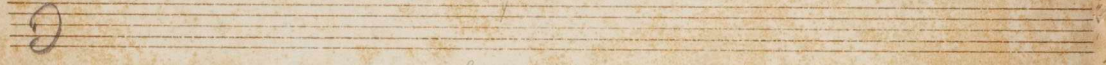


you said goodbye the parting words were spoken. I leave you now perhaps to kiss or gaze your back each tenderly
