be put out to Interest, which Interest I do give unto my said Mother & her
assigns for & during ^{all} the term of her natural life. & from & immediately
after the decease of my said mother, I do dispose of the said Principal
Monies as follows Viz. "I do give One hundred pounds thereof to the
Library of Philadelphia; and all the rest &c.
