

## TOMB OF JAMES MONROE,

Fifth President of United States.

This tribute to the worth of the lamented Monroe, occupies the most elevated position in Holywood Cemetery, the most beautiful burial place in Virginia. It may be seen from a very great distance. The following inscriptions on Copperplate are affixed to the sides of the immense block of granite which cover his remains.

JAMES MONROE, Born in Westmoreland County 28th April, 1758. Died in the City of New York, 4th July, 1831.

By Order of the General Assembly, His remains were removed to this Cemetry 5th July, 1858, as an evidence of the affection of Virginia for her Good and Honest Son. The Eminent Services performed by this patriot for his Country are enduring Monuments of his wisdom and virtue.
