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— The Eachus Place - near Rosemont. —

This Sketch shows the House and Grounds in front, as they were in summer, when we boarded with Mrs: Virgil Eachus. —

First in 1874, we occupied the rooms on the 2nd floor, north and front; later in 1878 and 1879, those on the same floor, on the South and front of the house.

This property of about 25 acres was purchased some years ago for use of "The Hospital of The Good Shepherd for Children." Another story was built upon the house in the form of a Mansard roof; and additions made at the north and rear, with some changes in the interior.

The front is not altered below the French roof, and the grounds are unchanged except by the removal of some trees and shrubbery.
