Mr Lewis was possessed of a perfect official education, having been fully prepared in Germany for a position as Secretary of the Ministerium of Ansbach-Bayreuth; which position was long held open for his acceptance, by the King of Prussia, after he had decided, (at the request of his bride) to remain in America and make it his home.

He had also been Secretary of his regiment from Ansbach-Bayreuth, as well as of his Battalion, and Acting Quartermaster.

His brother Johann Georg Gottfried Ludwig, born 9 May 1756 - 3^d son, at that time was Royal Bavarian Privy Councillor and Private Secretary of the King of Prussia at Ansbach, Bavaria, having written the Treaty of Basle, for which he was promoted by the King of Prussia, to be his First Secretary and Privy Councillor, with additional salary and gratuity.
